VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS

AGE REQUIREMENTS

Office /Service Volunteer- at least 18 years of age

Advocate Volunteer- at least 21 years of age

Special Event Volunteer- at least 18 years of age although teenagers over the age of 16 years may help at a single external event with legal guardian permission and at least one professional (teacher, coach, faith community, etc.) reference.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR ADULTS:

All volunteers must successfully complete an application and the following checks prior to serving:

- Personal Reference Check (at least 2 non-family members)
- Criminal Background Check
- Department of Family Protective Services
- Sex Offender Registry

The ECCC will not be able to accept volunteers who:

- Have a criminal charge or conviction relating to family violence, sexual assault, or child abuse
- Are currently on parole
- Have an investigative finding of Reason to Believe from DFPS

All other charges and convictions will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis in the terms of circumstance and context, age of charge/conviction, and type of charge/conviction.

REQUIRED TRAINING:

Office/Special Event Volunteers- 2- hour Orientation over CVAC/CAC and any additional information needed for volunteer assignment

Advocate Volunteer- Office of the Attorney General Sexual Assault Certified and Domestic Violence training (40 hours) completed over 4–8 weeks, depending on the volunteer's schedule and availability of guest lecturers. This will be followed by 10 hours of on-the-job training with a more experienced advocate.
